Bio Chia Amisola (b. 2000, Manila) is devoted to the internet's ambiences and its loss, love, labor, and (Med) liberation. Their games, performances, and websites take interest in the intimacies of infrastructures, the labor of tools, and the poetics of machines, as situated within the third world's ecologies from the domestic to the divine. They organize Developh towards an archipelagic internet; most recently curating KAKAKOMPYUTER MO YAN, an exhibition of Filipino internet art. Bio Chia Amisola (b. 2000, Manila) is devoted to the internet's ambiences and its loss, love, labor, and (Long) liberation. An artist, technologist, & designer situated within the third world internet's ecologies, their work takes interest in the intimacies of infrastructures and the labor of tools. Operating between the domestic and divine, they make (web)site-specific art as worlds: performances, games, tools, & environments that mend net art, software, systems, sound, archives, devotion, and networks - favoring agentic mediums that question the passivity of an ambience. Chia founded & stewards Developh (2016) and the Philippine Internet Archive (2023) towards a poetic, critical & archipelagic third world internet, recently curating & developing KAKAKOMPYUTER MO YAN, an independent exhibition of Filipino internet art & network cultures. Their practice also frequently presents in the indie games space, in conversation at the Game Developer Conference and experimental festivals such as Now Play This. They've exhibited internationally at space63, Manila; the V&A and Somerset House, London; InterAccess, Toronto; ACMI, Australia; WSA, NYC; panke.gallery, Berlin; and Gray Area, San Francisco. They've been featured in The New Yorker, Forbes, Frieze, BOMB Magazine, It's Nice That, Rappler, Nylon, Esquire, Manila Bulletin, et. al, and are a Forbes 30 Under 30 Asia recipient & Lumen Prize Winner.
